Peerless Umbrella is committed to providing safe and compliant products to our customers. We are a member of the PPAI Product Safety Aware program and integrate industry best practices throughout the organization.

Peerless Umbrella's compliance program is comprised of two primary parts:

- *Social Compliance* – All Peerless Umbrella suppliers must demonstrate compliance to a minimum Code of Conduct that ensures a legal and safe working environment. Our sourcing team works closely with each factory supplier and we push for increased transparency in our industry. In addition, Peerless ensures all suppliers have had a recent on-site third party social audit.
- *Product Safety Compliance* – All of our products are reviewed by third party experts to ensure compliance to all US compliance legislation, including the CPSIA and Calif Prop 65. A product safety assessment is part of our product development process to ensure all products are safe being producing them.

Peerless Umbrella Prop 65 and CPSIA Statement

As part of the Peerless Umbrella compliance program, we work to ensure that each product we sell meets all state and federal product regulations, including:

Consumer Protection Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA) – This act introduced many new testing and reporting requirements for a variety of products, particularly for items used by children. In addition, suppliers must be able to provide a "General Conformity Certificate" (GCC) for adult items and a "Children's Product Certificate" (CPC) for child items to all customers upon request.

Proposition 65 – the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 – Peerless Umbrella integrates prop 65 compliance into our product testing plan. We monitor Prop 65 legislation to ensure we meet requirements and we offer Prop 65 labeling upon request.
